

# Anticorruption court resources, staff and security

## Background

To become fully operational, the High Anticorruption Court needs to be provided with all the necessary resources and funds.

Although the court is functioning starting from September 2019, there is still unresolved issue of the court receiving permanent and adequate premises.

## Timeline

### Head of the Anti-Corruption Court apparatus has the house on one land plot with the SBI's deputy head

## Documents

### IMF

We will continue to ensure the full operationalization of the HACC, by providing adequate financial resources for its activities (including staffing and IT requirements and maintaining competitive staff remuneration) and ensuring a permanent and dedicated and adequate suitable facility for the HACC. By end-August 2020, the HACC will have been provided ownership of permanent offices (first instance and appellate levels) that are appropriate for its needs, and security services and protocols for its personnel and buildings.

Progress in making the High Anti-Corruption Court of Ukraine operational in line with the law “On the High Anti-Corruption Court” notably by (a) making significant progress with the selection of qualified and independent judges for this Court (at least submission by the High Qualification Commission of Judges of Ukraine to the High Council of Justice of the recommendations on the appointment of candidates for judge according to the results of the competition), and (b) ensuring that the Court has the financial resources to conduct its mission as prescribed by the law.
