

NABU intensified its attack on corruption in 2017 — Artem Sytnyk

From the very start of investigations, the Detectives of the National Anti-Corruption Bureau of Ukraine (NABU) and the prosecutors of the Specialized Anti-Corruption Prosecutor's Office (SAPO) have exposed more than 300 persons allegedly involved in the corruption crimes. Also 107 cases have already been sent to court. This was stated by the NABU Director Artem Sytnyk at the briefing «Presentation of the Report on the NABU results during the second half of 2017» on February, 2018. He underlined that pre-trial investigations as of the Chairman of the Accounting Chamber of Ukraine, the Former Head of the State Fiscal Service of Ukraine, the Former Head of the Verkhovna Rada Committee on Fuel and Energy Complex were completed last year.
